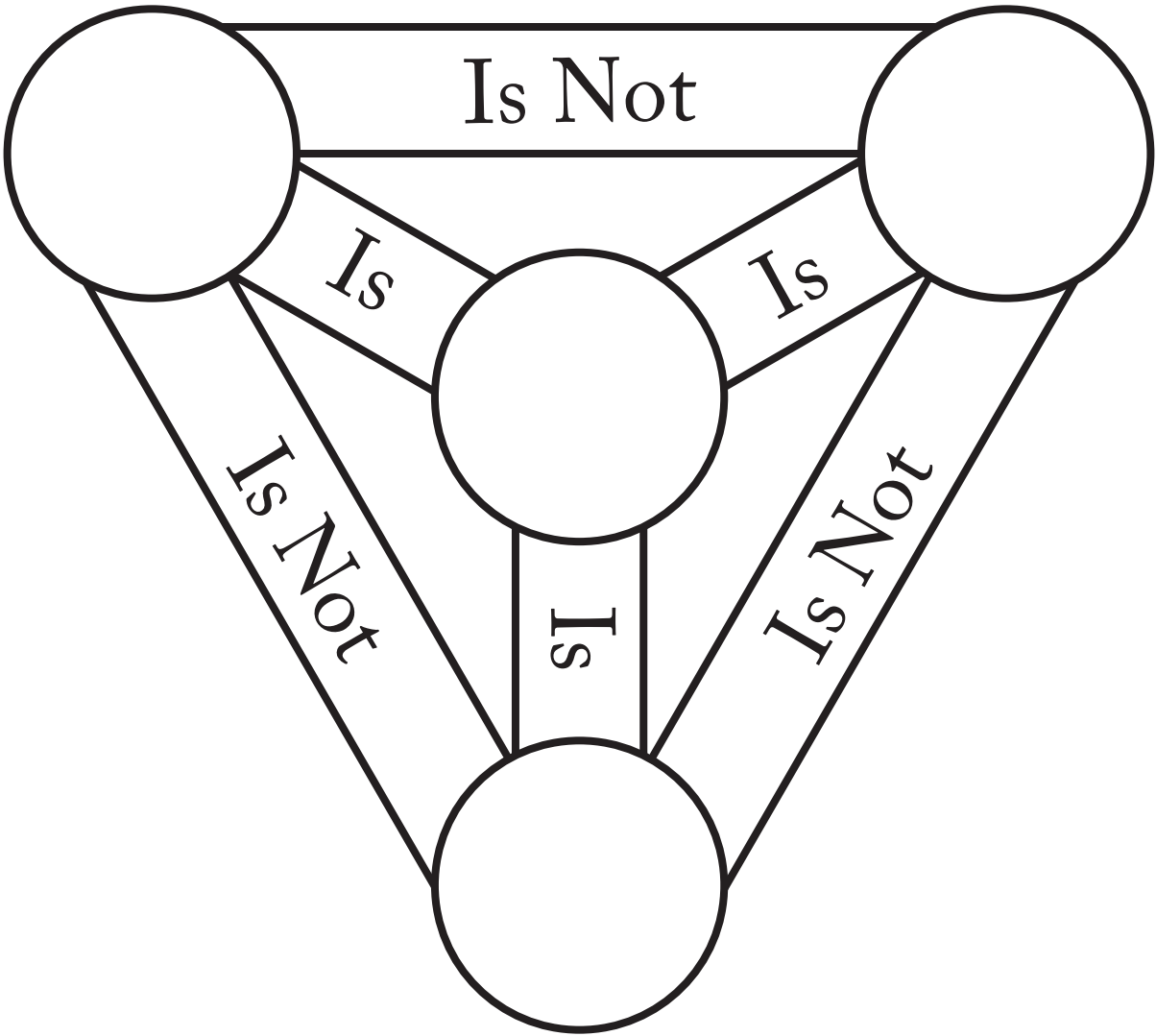


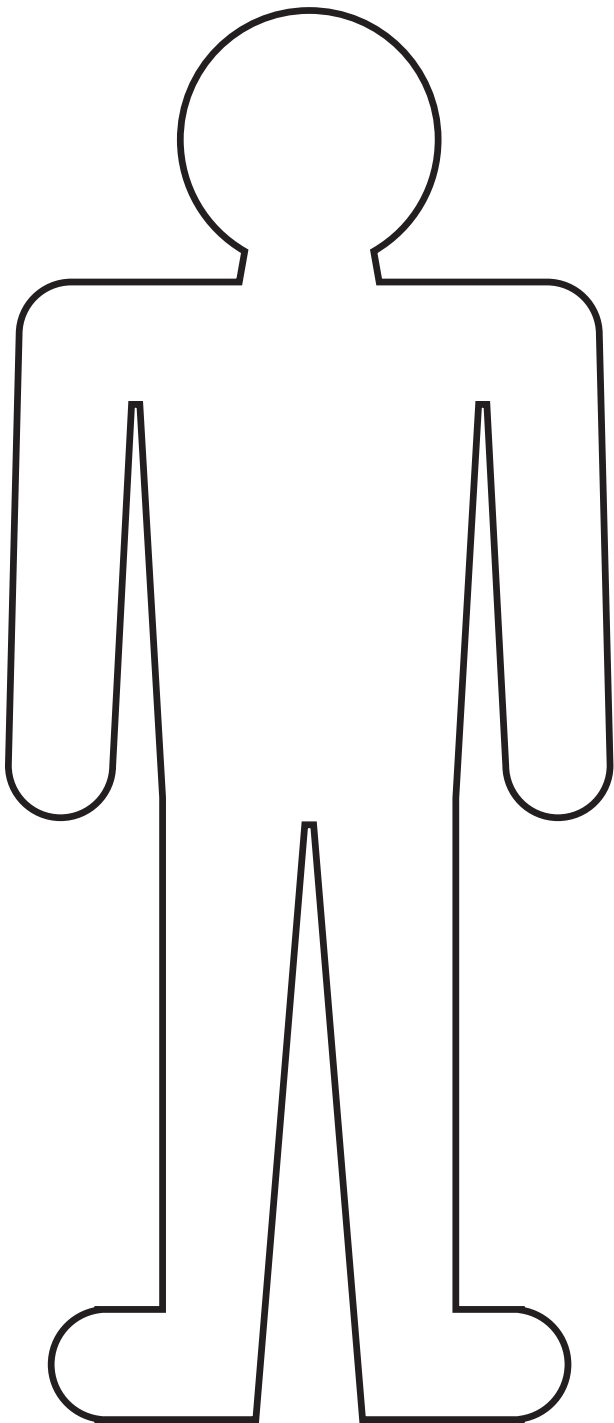

Ingredients:

Mix sugar, butter, eggs, and vanilla in large bowl. Beat on low to mix ingredients well. Beat on high for 5 minutes.

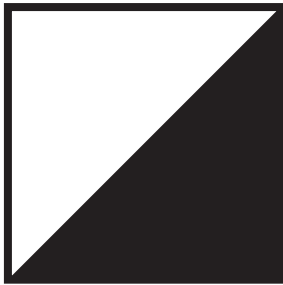
On low, add flour and baking powder alternately with milk.

Spoon batter into greased and floured 10-inch tube pan.

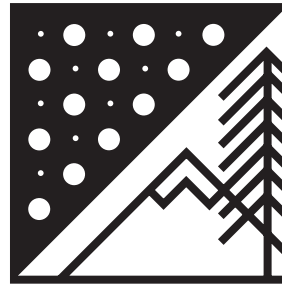

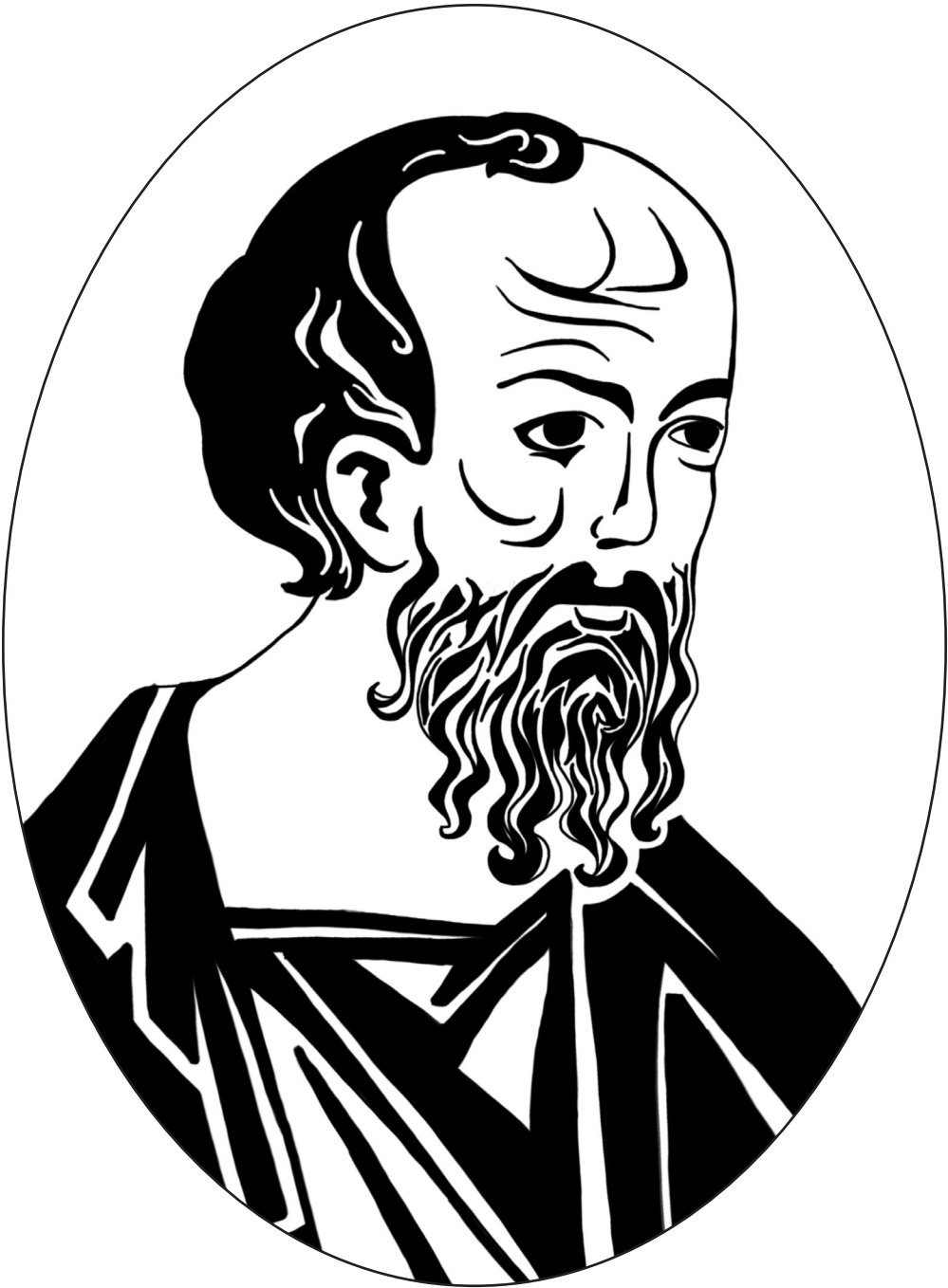


Does Christ's death mean all our sins can be forgiven?	Yes, because Christ's death on the cross fully paid the penalty for our sin, God will remember our sins no more.	Why was it necessary for Christ, the Redeemer, to die?	Christ died willingly in our place to deliver us from the power and penalty of sin and bring us back to God.
Why must the Redeemer be truly God?	That because of his divine nature his obedience and suffering would be perfect and effective.	Why must the Redeemer be truly human?	That in human nature he might on our behalf perfectly obey the whole law and suffer the punishment for human sin.

How can we glorify God?	By loving him and by obeying his commands and law.	What is our only hope in life and death?	That we are not our own but belong to God.

I hope you're very well and continuing to love the Lord Jesus. I know that you've been learning about the Lord's Supper in your class, and I want to warn you that some people are teaching wrong things about the Lord's Supper—please be sure to tell the children!

Some people are making a big mistake by believing that eating and drinking the bread and wine will make them Christians! This is definitely wrong—it says so in the Bible. The Lord's Supper will not save anyone, nor bring forgiveness to those who have not put their trust in Jesus. Be sure to tell the children that the Lord's Supper is a sacrament for those who believe; it will not bring belief.

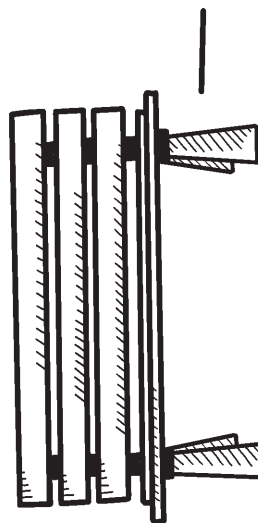

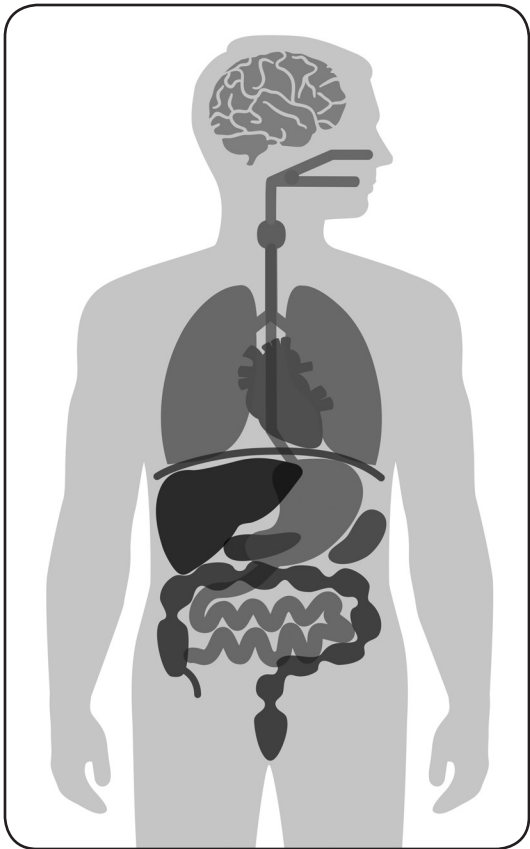
I hope you have a great class. Don't forget to tell the children about the false things people are teaching about the Lord's Supper.

Q3 Trinity Diagram



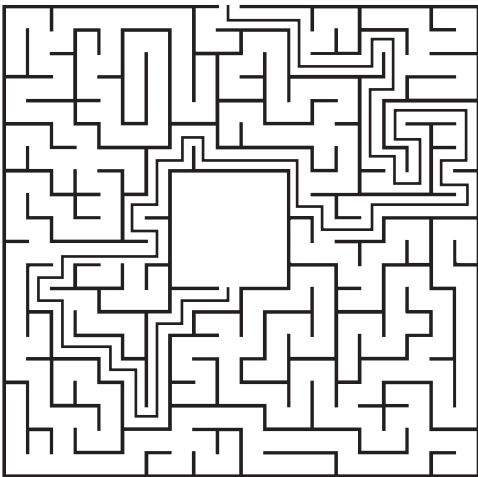

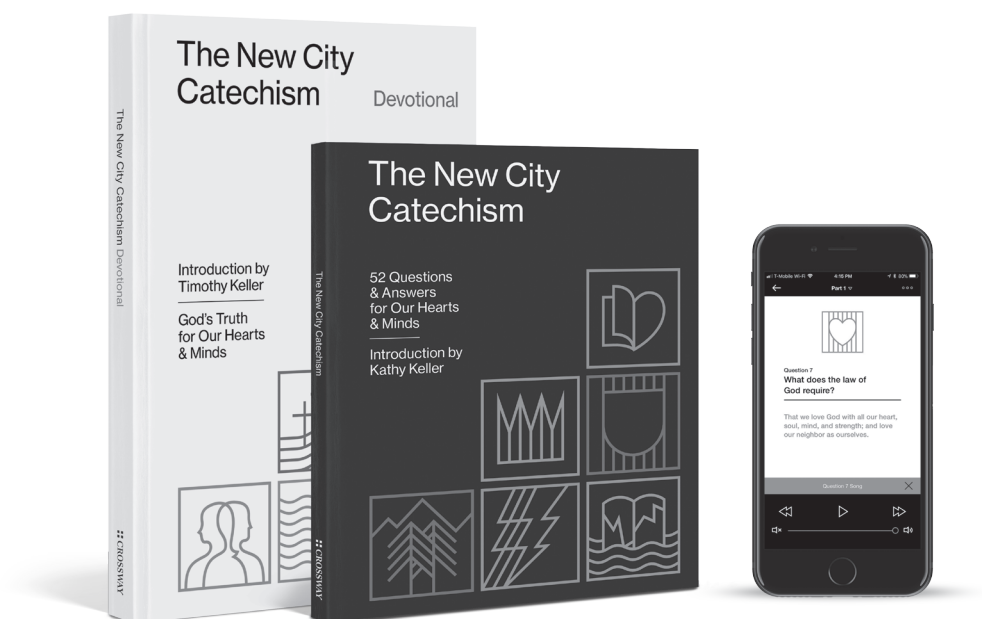
