
Leader/Helper Expectations:

Arrival & Dismissal of Children

Arrival:

- •Welcome children upon arrival!
 - NOTE: Pre-K gets dropped off in Chapel
- Note their attendance on the Roster Sheet
- •Note your attendance as well with your <u>initials</u>
- Collect tithes
- •Leave Tithes & Roster Sheet at end of pew (Pre-K in chapel)

Dismissal:

- NOTE: Pre-K pick-up in Chapel—1 way traffic
- Have a leader sit at each end of the pew to limit escapees
- Parent/Guardians are released by pews to minimize congestion
- Parent/Guardian <u>must show</u> the leader holding the Roster Sheet their photo id (id must match one of the names approved for pick-up on the Roster Sheet)
- Parent/Guardian then signs their name
- Child is free to go!

BASIC INFO

• 2 adult rule, if left with 1 child move immediately to a location where other adults are nearby & can see you.



- No physical discipline (See Behavior Modification Tips)
- Side hugs, pats on the back, fist bumps are appropriate for kids over 3 years old.
- Keep cell phones for emergencies, otherwise please do not use them.
- Bathroom: <u>3 yrs. Grade 3</u> minimal amt. of assistance per ability, but supervise always with 2 people present.
 <u>Over grade 3</u> kids may go to the bathroom with another student, but supervision must be nearby. Make certain kids return directly to the group.

ALLERGIES & FOOD SAFETY

- Kids should be calm & seated when eating. Be aware of any choking hazards.
- Food surfaces should be sanitized between groups. Plates, napkins used
- We are a nut free environment! Be very AWARE of any allergies of children in the group.
 - <u>EPIPEN</u>: allergic reaction > hives/rash, throat tightness, itching, wheezing, "funny itchy feeling" in throat/mouth
 - <u>CALL 911</u>, have child sit or lay down > administer Blue to sky; Orange to thigh; Press – Click – Hold
 - * Save the pen & return to parent/guardian

MISSING CHILD

- Do a quick search of the area including bathroom.
- If not immediately found notify leadership.
- Name, gender, age, physical description.
- The building will go on lock-down. Everyone will stay in place. No one except designated staff should be moving about until you are told the situation is resolved.
- Stay calm & do not panic children; pray with those who are scared
- Security may recruit available adults to man the doors & assist as needed.
