## The Great Rescue Study Guide

WORSHIP: Listen to this song called “He Will Hold me fast” by Kristyn Getty. And share any lines that stuck out to you as you listened to it.

REVIEW: Share something that stuck out to you or impacted you from the sermon this past week.

DISCUSS: Why is it important to understand “what are you saved FROM?”

SHARE: Share a time you were rescued from something, as big as saving your literal life, or as small as being saved from an embarrassing moment. What was it like to receive rescue from someone?

STUDY: Read Exodus 12 concerning the last plague (Passover). Listen closely to the “command of rescue” and the “Sign of the rescue” and the response in faithful obedience to that command. Now think about baptism in regard to “the command,” “the sign,” and the “faithful obedience” that we have been called to partake in.

PRAYER: Ask God to help you share the need for salvation (“you need to be saved from the wrath of God!”) in a way that is filled with both love and truth with those in your life! Neighbors, coworkers, family, etc.

ASK: What can we do to help share the message of God’s great rescue? What needs to change in our language that we stay connected with the idea that “there is no good person?” How can we remind ourselves that we should be asking, “why do GOOD things happen to BAD people?”
