

Home Group Questions for 8/24/25

Trusting God's Call

WORSHIP:

Listen to the song *Trust and Obey* (classic hymn, or Shane & Shane version). As you listen, reflect on the words about surrendering and following God's lead. Share a line that resonated with you in light of this week's sermon.

REVIEW:

Share something that stuck out to you or impacted you from the sermon this past week.

DISCUSS:

Why is "almost obedience" actually disobedience? How do comfort and distraction tempt us to "settle in Haran" instead of going all the way with God?

SHARE:

Share a time in your life when God asked you to step out in faith without knowing all the details. What did you learn about His faithfulness in that experience?

STUDY:

Read Hebrews 11:8-10. How does this passage describe Abraham's faith and perspective? How does it contrast with the people of Babel in Genesis 11? What can we learn about trusting God's unseen promises today?

PRAYER:

Pray that we would not settle for half-hearted obedience but would have faith to go where God calls us, even when it's uncomfortable. Ask God to increase our trust in His promises and to help us worship in the "in-between."

ASK:

- Where might you be "settling in Haran" instead of fully following God's call?
- What "securities" in your life are hardest to leave behind when God asks you to trust Him?
- How can remembering God's past faithfulness give you courage for today's call?
