How is this passage similar to Matt. 28:18-20?

Read Isa. 6:8. How is God calling me to be sent today? How should I answer that call?

Skim the rest of chapter 6, and chapters 7-9. What kind of messages is God asking Isaiah to deliver? What would similar messages look like to our culture today?
